Central Coast Fire District is located on the beautiful, scenic Pacific coast of central Oregon. The district was established in 1999 and currently provides Fire, water rescue and non transport EMS service from three stations. The approximately 37 square mile service area includes the communities of Waldport, Tidewater and Five Rivers.

The ideal Fire Chief will be an active, involved part of the community, work effectively with the Board of Directors, demonstrate strong fiscal accountability and provide fair, honest, effective leadership to the paid staff and 25 volunteers. The Chief is expected to work closely with the City, County, State and Federal partners as well as neighboring Fire Districts.

The District is looking for an experienced leader who can demonstrate a progressively more responsible Fire Service career history in a similar or larger combination department which provides fire, EMS and wildland urban interface services and can provide proactive approach to addressing the future needs of the District. A background in Fire Prevention/Code Enforcement and successful grant writing would be desirable.

Experienced candidates who may be looking to work less than full-time are encouraged to apply.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Associates Degree (EFO or Bachelors preferred) in Fire administration, Public administration or other closely related field or a satisfactory combination of education and experience that demonstrate the ability to perform the Fire Chief Job duties.
2. Eight (8) year's full-time paid experience with a combination department with at least five (5) years of supervisory experience in a command position of Captain or higher.
3. EMT Basic (Paramedic preferred).
4. Valid Oregon Drivers license, insurable by District's insurance carrier.
